BEFORE THE MOVE

0	Make a list of your services and providers - gas, electric, TV, broadband, banks,
	water etc: Look through your direct debits to confirm.
0	Cancel any subscriptions you will no longer need - E.g milk deliveries
\bigcirc	Make removal arrangements - If you are hiring a van, they get booked up fast
\bigcirc	Arrange home insurance for your new property - This needs to be in place for
	exchange of contracts, not just completion
\circ	Start packing non-essential items - Things you don't need before the move
\bigcirc	Declutter - Use the move as an opportunity to sell or donate unwanted items
\bigcirc	Prepare an essentials box - you will be living out of boxes for a bit - keep kettles,
	mugs, biscuits, tea and toilet roll handy!
	THE DAY OF THE MOVE

\bigcirc	Take final meter readings - Gas, water, electric - photos are a good idea Chack all reages and storage appears depit forget the shed left and supported.

\bigcirc	Defrost your Freezer - Switch this off the night before - you don't want this to defrost in the removals van!
\circ	Collect ALL of your keys and confirm handover - Check with the agent/seller,
\cup	normally they are released once the solicitors confirm the transfer of funds
\bigcirc	Keep your phone charged - You'll need this throughout the day
	AFTER THE MOVE
\bigcirc	Take meter readings at your new home - Gas, electric, water - take photos,
	these are useful in case of disputes with your provider
\bigcirc	Unpack essentials first - Get that kettle out - you'll need a cuppa
\bigcirc	Test smoke alarms and other detectors - Replace batteries and faulty alarms
Ō	Change the locks - You never know who still has a key from the past
Õ	Notify your suppliers - Work through your list and confirm your address change
Ŏ	Register with a local GP - It's good to get this done early
\circ	Locate the water stopcock, fuse box and boiler - especially if you are doing DIY
\bigcirc	Ensure your home insurance is active - Double check it has started
